## Lunch boxes

Please also be aware that children who use a baby bottle with a teat designed for 0-18 months will be affecting their teeth and speech and language communication needs, so we will be encouraging them to drink from a cup. Please note some shop bought drinks are not suitable for under 3 years of age as they have removable small lids.

**Show and Tell** – don't forget children are welcome to bring in a toy/book/photo for show and tell to discuss and show to their peers this promotes great discussions and new vocabulary.

**School Admissions** – you can apply online at torbay.gov.uk from 1 November 2024 until 15 January 2025 if your child was born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021.

**Holiday Form and Termination Form** - Don't forget if you go away on holiday or are leaving the setting we need four weeks' notice and a form filled in. We also need to know their new setting, in order to send their transition form to help your child settle in.

**Children in Need** – On Friday 15 November we shall be supporting Children in Need by having a spotty day. Your child may dress up if they wish to join in and a small donation for children in need will be appreciated.

**Christmas trip-** we are going to Kents Cavern for our annual Christmas trip this year on Monday 16 December at 10.00 until or 11.30 All staff will be going so the preschool will be closed for this period.
